He attended Gallaudet College, Washington, D.C. (1946-1948), a graduate of Baylor University, Waco, TX (1948-1951) B.A., Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary Ft Worth, TX, (1951-1952), New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, New Orleans, LA, (1952-1954 and Columbia Theological Seminary, Decatur, Georgia (1962-1966) Th.M. He served as Superintendent of Deaf Missions, Southern Baptist Convention (1955-1956), Missionary to the Deaf both in TN and GA (1957-1967). He has taught several Extension courses as well as two-week intensive courses at Fuller Theological Seminary in CA, and Boyce Bible College in Louisville, KY and three different courses at the Tri-State School of Theology for the Deaf under the Boyce Bible College program in Ridgecrest, NC.

He is married to the former Wanda Irene Parker. They have three married children (Carter Jr., Ray Conrad and Sharon Gay).
